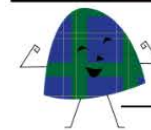

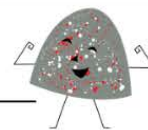

WHAT?

Join us in our 11th annual Tap 24.7 professional production!

WHERE?

Auditions will take place either via video starting June 15th, or in person at Tap Dance Detroit on August 2nd. Rehearsals will be in person and over Zoom. The show will be at The Berman Center, a beautiful venue in West Bloomfield, MI.

WHEN?

Rehearsals take place on Saturdays or Sundays, however the choreography and rehearsal videos will always be posted online via Facebook groups, so it's okay to miss some weekends! Show weekend is October 28-30.

WHO?

We accept tap dancers across the country of varying age, skill, and commitment levels! This is a flexible experience that you can tailor to fit your own schedule and budget. If you love tap and want high-quality professional experience, this is a great show for you!



HOW TO AUDITION

- 1 Reach out to Suzy Hall via email: tapzen24.7@gmail.com
- 2 You will receive a video of broken-down choreography that you can take time to learn and practice on your own.
- 3 Submit a video of yourself doing the choreography along with any other requested information!

FAQ

Q: I have a really busy schedule, do I need to be at every rehearsal?

A: Not at all! Every rehearsal video will be posted along with a breakdown of any choreography that you are expected to learn. Although in-person attendance is encouraged, it is not required until the week of the show.

Q: How many dances will I be in?

A: After we review your audition video, you will be contacted with the number of dances you have been cast in. At this point, you may either choose to accept that number, or choose to perform in less dances if that better suits your availability. Even if you only have time for one dance, we would love to have you!

Q: What will it cost?

A: We work hard to make everything as affordable as possible while still offering a high quality, professional experience for young dancers. The cost depends on the number of routines you choose to accept after being casted, so this can be lowered to suit your financial needs.

REGISTRATION FEE: \$40

FEE PER DANCE: \$100 (\$100 FOR BOTH OPENING AND CLOSING)

MEDIA FEE: \$25 (INCLUDES DIGITAL DOWNLOAD OF BOTH SHOWS AND PICTURES)
